

Quicken for Windows Conversion Instructions

Express Web Connect to Direct Connect

Introduction

As *AmFirst Bank* completes its system conversion to *Bank of Colorado*, you will need to modify your Quicken settings to ensure the smooth transition of your data. Please reference the dates next to each task as this information is time sensitive.

To complete these instructions, you will need your User ID and Password for each Financial Institution.

NOTE: Express Web Connect uses the same User ID and Password as the *AmFirst Bank* website. **Direct Connect** for *Bank of Colorado* may require registration. Please contact your financial institution to verify your Direct Connect login information.

You should perform the following instructions exactly as described and in the order presented. If you do not, your online banking connectivity may stop functioning properly. This conversion should take 15–30 minutes.

Documentation and Procedures

Task 1: Conversion Preparation

 Backup your data file. For instructions to back up your data file, choose Help menu > Quicken Help. Search for Backup Data File and follow the instructions. 2. Download the latest Quicken Update. For instructions to download an update, choose **Help** menu > **Quicken Help**. Search for *Update Software* and follow the instructions.

Task 2: Connect to AmFirst Bank for a final download before 4pm MST on July 1, 2017

- 1. Choose **Tools** menu > **One Step Update**.
- 2. Depending on how you manage financial institution passwords, you may be prompted to enter your Vault password at this time or to enter individual passwords in the One Step Update dialog.
- In the One Step Update Settings dialog, make sure all items are checked and click Update Now.
- 4. If new transactions were received from your connection, accept all new transactions into the appropriate registers.

NOTE:

If you need assistance matching transactions, choose **Help menu > Quicken Help**. Search for **Matching Transactions** and follow the instructions.

Task 3: Disconnect Accounts At AmFirst Bank on or after July 5, 2017

- 1. Choose **Tools** menu > **Account List**.
- 2. Click the **Edit** button of the account you want to deactivate.
- 3. In the **Account Details** dialog, click on the **Online Services** tab.
- 4. Click **Deactivate.** Follow the prompts to confirm the deactivation.
- 5. Click on the General tab.
- 6. Remove the financial institution name and account number. Click **OK** to close the window.
- 7. Repeat steps for each account to be disconnected.

Task 4: Reconnect Accounts to Bank of Colorado on or after July 5, 2017

- 1. Choose Tools menu > Account List.
- 2. Click the Edit button of the account you want to activate.
- 3. In the Account Details dialog, click on the Online Services tab.
- 4. Click Set up Now.
- 5. Use Advanced Setup to activate your account.
- 6. Enter *Bank of Colorado (for retail users) or Bank of Colorado Business (for business users)* in the search field, select the name in the list and click Next.

- 7. If presented with the Select Connection Method screen, select **Direct Connect**.
- 8. Type your Direct Connect **User ID** and **Password** and click **Connect**.
- Ensure you associate the account to the appropriate account already listed in Quicken. You will
 want to select Link to an existing account and select the matching accounts in the drop-down
 menu.

IMPORTANT: Do NOT select Add to Quicken unless you want to add a new account to Quicken. If you are presented with accounts you do not want to track in this data file, select Ignore – Don't Download into Quicken.

- 10. After all accounts have been matched, click **Next**. You will receive confirmation that your accounts have been added.
- 11. Click Done or Finish.
